Physical Education Mrs. Lozar Mr. Zornow	We are concluding our volleyball unit this week. We will continue to work on net game strategies with a 3 lesson unit of eclipse ball. Eclipse ball is a racquet game with similar strategies and rules to volleyball. We will conclude the trimester with reviewing basic fitness concepts learned with the IHT heart rate monitors and introduce the concepts of muscle strength vs muscle endurance. The rollerblading unit will begin March 5th. Students will be required to wear helmets and wrist guards. Students can bring skates from home as long as they have a brake and the label their equipment with their name. Equipment can be kept in our storage closet in the fitness center. Typically more than 100 students bring their own equipment so labeling them with names is super important.
