Lots to share this month so let's get right to it...

#### Parent-Teacher Conferences

Conferences will be held on **Thursday, October 17, 1:00pm-8:00pm**. Individual conference sessions will be 10 minutes in length and offered as an in-person event. Please follow the directions below to register. The window of time to access conference scheduling on our website will start at **6:00am on Wednesday, October 9** and will remain open until **noon on Wednesday, October 16**. To register follow these directions:

- 1. Go to www.wdpsd.com, then click on Middle School  $\rightarrow$  Parent Info  $\rightarrow$  Conferences.
- 2. Follow the directions for scheduling a conference as a parent through **Conference Manager**.
  - a. First, you will need to register for an account. After that, you will be able to sign in with the email address and password you created.
  - b. When you register, add the names of all your children and the school in which they attend.
  - c. If your child has changed schools since last year (moved to grade 7 from grade 6), make sure the correct school is aligned with your child. Changes like this can be made under "my profile."
  - d. Select the conference that you wish to attend.
  - e. Select the teachers you would like to meet with.
  - f. Select the time slot you would like for each teacher.
  - g. Click on the My Conferences tab to review, edit, or print your schedule.
- 3. Once you register, you should receive an email from Conference Manager.

#### **Dress Code**

Page 15 of the 2024 student handbook describes our student dress code. On some occasions (not often), students who are in violation of the dress code may be required to rectify the issue immediately with a change of clothes. We recognize that sometimes can cause an inconvenience for parents, who may have to bring a change of clothes to school for their child. In other situations (more commonly), the student may be allowed to finish out the day as dressed, but reminded not to wear those clothing articles to school again. These determinations will be made by the administration on case-by-case basis. Should you have questions about the dress code, certainly feel free to contact me.





# **The Healing Power of Animals**

Research has shown that therapy dogs support psychological and academic growth while increasing social skills and self-esteem in children and adolescents. Therapy dogs have been trained to provide emotional support which positively impacts academic skills, emotional functioning and communication skills. In addition, the use of therapy dogs may decrease anxiety, improve self-esteem and increase overall academic achievement in students.

# Ways We Can Use Maverick at WDPMS

- → Positive presence on campus
- → Work with students 1-1 having a hard day, working through grief, anxiety, life changes
- → Work with students in a group counseling experience
- → Sit with students while they read/work
- → Come into classrooms

# **Procedures for Interacting with Mayerick**

- → Maverick loves to be pet and get ear rubs
- → Students can pet him 1 student at a time and approach him calmly
- → Maverick will always be with Mrs. Karlen on a leash
- → Maverick has a very sensitive tummy and can not be given any food, except for his regular food or any treats that Mrs. Karlen has on hand.
