<p><b><u>Art</u></b> Mrs. Lowe</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>5th Grade:</b> Students are starting their stop-motion animation unit this month! Students will start the year reviewing gym procedures and building community with team building activities. Don't forget students must have proper footwear in order to participate in class. No crocs, sandals or boots. We will allow students to borrow from our shoe library if they forget.</p>

<p><b><u>STEM</u></b> Mrs. Kohl</p>	<p><b>General STEM:</b> -We would love your recycled <i>cereal boxes, paper towel cardboard inserts</i> and <i>caps to detergent bottles</i>. Feel free to send them with your child to STEM or drop them off in the office labeled "STEM." Also, if you are looking to get rid of any types of toys that students could construct things with, we would take those off your hands as well. Thanks in advance!</p> <p><b>5th Grade STEM:</b> Students begin the year doing a unit called Measuring Time. In this they will do a variety of experiments with ways to measure time. At the end they will create a 30 second timer.</p> <p><b>6th Grade STEM:</b> 6th grade students will begin the year with a cardboard construction unit. They'll use Virtual Reality to view different structures and then design and create their own.</p>

<p><b><u>World</u></b> <b><u>Language-French</u></b> <b>(6th Grade)</b> Madame VDB-</p>	<p><b><u>French Class:</u></b></p> <p>MERCI to everyone who has already turned in the \$1 that was listed on the school supply list for French class! If you have not yet sent your \$1 to school, please do so at your earliest convenience. This can be turned in to Madame VDB or to your child's homeroom teacher. The \$1 will go towards paying for treats that will be provided later in the semester when family members will be invited in to view a French performance put on by the students.</p> <p><b><u>French Club:</u></b></p> <p>Sixth grade students are invited to join the French Club this year! <p><b><u>World</u></b> <b><u>Language-Spanish</u></b> <b>(6th Grade)</b> <b><u>Señora Steingraber</u></b></p>	<p><b>Spanish Class: Students and Families:</b> Hola to students and families that have me this semester! The year has started off fantástico! This year students will be learning a mini conversation in Spanish and Spanish basics. Before they leave for Thanksgiving break they will be tested on the conversation and another oral presentation towards the end of the semester. Parents will be invited to the second presentation. Emails will be sent closer to the time. I will also be sending a syllabus home with each student so that you have more information on how to contact me and the class.</p> <p><b>Spanish club:</b> Sixth graders are invited to join the Spanish Club this year. You may still join if you are not in Spanish yet. Students are allowed to be in both Spanish and French clubs in 6th grade.</p> <p>There will be one Spanish club event per month all year long. Tuesday September 24 will be our first getting to know each other event. The cost is a one time per year \$5 contribution that will be used for our club fiestas and activities throughout the year. We meet in the Spanish room and walk to the middle school. Students should be picked up in front of the middle school at 330 for the first meeting. Sign up sheets are in the Spanish room.</p>
