<p><u>Physical Education</u></p> <p>Mrs. Lozar Mr. Zornow</p>	<p>5th/ 6th grade students have begun a flag football unit. Students focus on throwing and catching the football while moving. 5th and 6th graders are introduced to 4 passing plays-hook, slant, in, and fly. We will work toward incorporating the strategy into a game of 4 v 4. Throughout the unit, we focus on the foundation we established during team building. Game play has a focus of communication, teamwork, sportsmanship, staying calm, listening to others, and giving our best effort.</p>
<p><u>STEM</u></p> <p>Mrs. Kohl</p>	<p>General STEM: If your family uses any of the following, we would love to take these recycled items off your hands. Students can bring items to the STEM room or turn them in to the office labeled “STEM.”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cereal boxes (we will be using 500 of these) • Paper towel/ wrapping paper cardboard inserts <p>5th Grade STEM: Students are still in the Measuring Time Unit. At the end of the unit each person will invent a way to measure 30 seconds as part of the engineering/design process.</p> <p>6th Grade STEM: Instead of the coding unit 6th graders started a 3-D Cardboard Construction project. They took virtual reality field trips to visit skyscrapers, bridges, and pyramids to find inspiration. They will create one of these out of the cardboard from a cereal box (which is why we’ll need 500). This goes along with the engineering/design process.</p>
